**China Yuan Wang signs distribution agreement with
Mobitex Technology AB to offer Mabitex®
to electric power market in China**

Gothenburg (Sweden), April 27, 2009 - Mabitex Technology AB and Yuan Wang Technique & Equipment Co. Ltd. have entered into an agreement, outlining close co-operation for the development and distribution of Mabitex equipment, specifically tailored for the Chinese electricity grid.

The collaboration between the two companies will provide local distribution of Mabitex technology at 230 MHz frequency availability as a network technology of choice for grid monitoring and control. Mabitex technology has undergone extensive suitability testing to enable it to be approved for use in the Chinese national grid.

China is now seeing a rapid increase in demand for power and in order to satisfy the demand, needs to not only supply new power stations but also to dramatically improve the efficiency of the distribution network. By 2010, the capacity is expected to be almost doubled. However, building new capacity alone cannot solve the supply problem - when grid efficiency can be as low as 60%.

"We are delighted to have formed a close relationship with such a well respected and experienced partner as Yuan Wang", says Rich Pullin, Managing Director of Mabitex Technology Division. "This agreement puts Mabitex networking technology at the heart of a major, well-funded public sector project. We are looking forward to driving the project forward and to further strengthening our co-operation with Yuanwang over the coming weeks and months."

China is currently undertaking one of the largest infrastructure investments in the world, where investment in the power grid alone will reach USD \$160 billion between 2007 and 2010. The government's five year plan has specified that all electricity transformers above a certain level (10 KVA) must be monitored and, preferably, controlled remotely. A government budget of \$500M per year has been set aside for wireless data automation programmes, in order to address the issues of line loss and power outages.

As Mabitex® is a wireless network with an extremely high level of security and reliability, the technology is ideal for deployment to resolve these challenges. The technology is specially designed for business critical applications and is already used worldwide for transferring particularly sensitive

information over private and secure wireless network connections. Over the past 5 years Mobitex has been developing its presence in China as well as re-engineering its core products to better suit the specific frequency and operational requirements of the power sector.

Being a state founded key public sector communications supplier, Yuan Wang has a long track record of supplying technology to Chinese government and military projects and can provide the necessary local contact to ensure that Mobitex succeeds in meeting these tough demands.

Through this agreement, Mobitex Technology AB is appointing Yuan Wang as exclusive distributor for its recently released 230 MHz solution within the Chinese market. The companies expect sales of tens of thousands of monitoring and control units over the first two years of the agreement..
